


Global demand for vegetable oil is growing fast

Relatively cheap





The expansion of plantations to meet global demand for vegetable oils could happen at the expense of forests, wildlife and communities.


Percentage of Population Living **Below National Proverty Line**

GLOBAL BIODIVERSITY : SPECIES NUMBERS OF VASCULAR PLANTS




Diversity Zones (DZ) : Number of Species per 10.000km²




Certified Area

RSPO supports smallholders to improve their livelihoods by targeting improved management practices, better quality fresh fruit bunches, increased yields and access to markets.






RSPO Smallholders Support Fund grants up to 100% of certification cost to smallholders.
